BLOCK OF THE MONTH - April, Scrap it up with the Pineapple Suite

** Decide what color you want to make your pineapple. This block will be referred to as yellow. Use $\frac{1}{2}$ " seams.

Scraps needed:

5" squares: 2 white, 1 green, 1 yellow or color of the pineapple

3" squares: 16 scrap variations of the color for the pineapple, 2 green, 2 white.

Take the 5" squares, 1 white and one green and one white and one yellow, sew right sides together, sew ¼" around the 5" square. Cut on the diagonal x2. Use a ruler with a 45 degree line, trim to 3" square. This will make 4 green & white half square triangles and 4 yellow & white half square triangles.

After making the half square triangles, lay out the 3" squares and half square triangles in order as in picture below, sew each row, alternate seams. This quilt was featured in Easy Quilts magazine in the spring issue of 2019.
