Block of the Month-March 2008

For March we will make a Kites Block. Background B will be a blue sky. Use bright scraps to make your two kites. Block finishes as a 8" square(8 ½" square unfinished).

Cut: background B: 2 B patches

Assorted kites: cut 2 A patches & 2 A-reverse patches

Also cut 2 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Cut the 2 3 ½" squares on the diagonal (you will only use one triangle of each color for this block).

Sew one A patch & one A-reverse patch to one B patch, matching dots. Repeat for second B patch. Now carefully sew the kite bottoms together. Finally sew an assorted A triangle to the ends of the kites. Now embroider kite tails. And finish the tails with knots of embroidery floss or make and attach small ribbons. Your kites are ready to fly!
